## “membership application checklist”

**PLEASE READ:** Thank you for applying to be a member of Wall First Aid & Rescue Squad! The following checklist will guide you to complete the necessary steps for becoming a new member. - 1. Submit an online application with the appropriate information.  
(<http://wallfirstaid.com/apply-online/>)
- 2. Wait to receive a phone call from our membership committee. They will schedule an in-person interview with you at our building: 1900 Monmouth Blvd, Wall, NJ.
- 3. Attend your in-person interview. Bring a filled out background check form, as well as a copy of your CPR certification if you have one.

- 4. Call Wall Township Police Department’s records bureau to schedule and complete a background check and fingerprinting. Their phone number is (732)-449-4500, and their address is 2700 Allaire Rd, Wall, NJ. Notify the membership committee after you have completed this step.
- 5. Wait for the membership committee to notify you when your ID card is ready. Then pick it up at the next squad meeting: the first Friday of every month at 7 pm.
- 6. Work with the membership committee to schedule and complete CPR or EVOC training as needed. (This can happen as soon as your ID card is ready, even if you have not yet picked it up).
- 7. Collect a pager and uniform supplies. (You must have possession of your ID card at this point).
- 8. Begin answering calls on a chosen duty crew night, and during daytime hours as available. Contact membership with any remaining questions.
